


## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The GEARUP™ KAYAK Wall Storage Rack is designed to hold one non-motorized kayak or canoe. Total weight of kayak or canoe should not exceed 200lbs.



# SAFETY NOTICE

## READ BEFORE INSTALLING AND USE

- 1. **BEFORE DRILLING & INSTALLING** mounting hardware **BE SURE NO** electrical, gas, water, or other obstructions will be interfered or damaged. **NOTE:** Drilling into electrical or gas lines can result in serious injury, death, and/or fire. If unsure of the exact location of these obstructions, seek Professional help.
- 2. **DO NOT INSTALL** over personnel, work areas, and/or walkways.
- 3. **BEFORE INSTALLING BE SURE** structure where Kayak Wall Storage Rack is to be attached is **ADEQUATE** enough to support the Kayak Wall Storage Rack and the load to be stored. If unsure, seek Professional help.
- 4. **BEFORE LIFTING BE SURE** no person and/or animals are under or near the load to be lifted.
- 5. **BEFORE LIFTING** perform visual check of the Kayak Wall Storage Rack arms ensuring they are firmly attached to the wall.
- 6. **BEFORE LIFTING** perform visual check of the Kayak Wall Storage Rack. **DO NOT USE** if any part of the storage rack shows signs of wear.
- 7. MAXIMUM WEIGHT capacity is 200 pounds
- 8. The Kayak Wall Storage Rack is designed for indoor use **ONLY**.

## **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **STEP ONE – Determine Location**

- 1. Determine location where the Kayak Wall Storage Rack is to be installed. Remember, check for electrical, gas, water, and/or other items that could be compromised or damaged during the installation.
- 2. The area where the Kayak Wall Storage Rack is to be attached **MUST BE** a solid structure and capable of holding the Kayak Wall Storage Rack and the boat being stored.
- 3. The location selected **MUST PROVIDE** adequate clearance to walls and other obstructions.

#### **STEP TWO – Installation**

- 4. Determine location where the Kayak Wall Storage Rack is to be installed. Remember, check for electrical, gas, water, and/or other items that could be compromised or damaged during the installation. This unit must be attached to a solid vertical wall stud (2 x 4 or greater) or similar type of solid material.
- 5. Locate exact centerline of wall stud.
- 6. Place unit on exact centerline of the wall studs. Adjust height as desired. Mark mounting holes on wall. You'll want to place the storage hooks as far apart as possible while still installing into wall studs to ensure the best and safest storage of your kayak/canoe. ALSO make sure the two arms are level with each other
- 7. Drill pilot holes for mounting screws marked in step 3 above. Remember to use a bit about 1/2 the size of the mounting screws.
- 8. Place unit back on exact centerline and attach unit to wall, screwing the mounting screws through the unit and into the pilot holes. Tighten screws until unit is sung against the wall.
- 9. When loading unit, gently lift your boat in place, ensuring the weight is evenly distributed. If you are concerned with lifting at all please seek assistance and always be safe. **NOTE: IF BOAT IS NOT BALANCED, IT COULD FALL.**

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING THE KAYAK WALL STORAGE RACK

#### Lifting and Storage

- 1. **DO NOT** try to lift anymore weight than you are comfortable in lifting, if you have any doubt, seek the help of others. Additionally, remember the total load weight of the storage rack and boat cannot exceed 200lbs total
- 2. **MAKE SURE** no people or pets are under or near the load to be lifted.
- 3. **BE SURE** the load is evenly balanced
- 4. **GENTLY** lift the item(s) on to the storage rack and slowly release the weight of the item the more tilt you have from front to back of the storage hooks the more stable the boat will be when resting in the hooks
- 5. Make sure your kayak does not slide or tilt from the wall & check that it is level when resting in the hooks

## DO NOT STEP, CLIMB, OR HANG ON THE STORAGE RACK
