



INSTALLATION STEPS

1 Measure the Space

Determine the length of your surfboard and the area where you plan to mount it on the wall. Ensure there is sufficient space for the surfboard.

2 Locate the Stud


Use a stud finder to identify and mark the center of the wall stud that will support the Base. It's crucial to mount the Base on a stud to bear the weight of the surfboard.

Mark the Base Position

Position the Base (A) against the wall at the desired mounting location. Mark the two mounting holes. Pre-drill these marked spots with a 3/16" drill bit.

Attach the Base

Secure the Base (A) to the wall using the Metal and Rubber Washers (J) and the Lag Screws (H). Ensure the rubber side of the washer faces the wall and the metal side faces outward. Use an extension bit to fasten the bottom screw through the cutout slot in the Base. Attach the Rubber Screw Caps (K) by pressing them onto the screw head.




5 Mark the Side Hook Locations


With the help of another person, place the surfboard onto the Base. Hold it steady and mark the edge locations where you plan to mount the Side Hooks. Make sure the surfboard is level and mark the edges lightly with a pencil or a piece of tape.

6 Measure for Side Hook Brackets

Remove the surfboard and verify the level of the marks. The screw location will be 3-5/8" inside of the edge location. Measure this distance and position the Side Hook Brackets (B & C) against the wall to mark the hole locations for both sides.





See through view with surfboard mounted to see hole locations behind edges



7 Drill Pilot Holes


Use a 3/16" drill bit to drill pilot holes for the Drywall Anchors (L). Insert the anchors into the holes until the front edge is flush or slightly protruding from the wall.





Install the Surfboard

Place the surfboard onto the Base and insert the Side Hooks (D & E) into the Side Hook Brackets (B & C). Secure the Side Hook Brackets in place with the Side Hook Lock (F).



Adjust if Necessary

If the Side Hooks are too tight, adjust them by moving them out to lock them in the alternate notch in the Side Hook Bracket.
