#### **5 Tier SUP Rack**

## Caution – Failure to follow these guidelines can result in property damage or personal injury.


- Parts are not labeled. Before assembly, please identify each part according to the descriptions and diagrams below.
- Do not use if the product or any parts is defective.
- Do not tilt or lift the storage rack.
- Do not drop SUP or any object on the rack. Place objects carefully and slowly.
- Do not step, stand, or climb on the storage unit.
- Do not use if loads are not balanced and / or cannot be used on level and secure ground. Always make sure the rack will not tip over. Secure the rack to the wall or floor if necessary.
- Always make sure heavier loads are at the bottom and never place product on upper rack position with the bottom rack empty. Top-heavy loads are dangerous.
- · Use only if you determine the rack can be used safely.
- The manufacture and its agents are not responsible for any damages or injuries caused by the use or misuse of the product.
- This rack is intended for indoor use only.
- Please follow the instructions and observe weight and size limits. 40 Lbs and 14 feet length maximum load per tier. Load and size limits are per pair of cradles. Maximum Total Load: 200 lbs.
- When moving the storage rack, remove all objects from the rack.

- B. Cross connector square tube (1 PC)
- C. Base Post (2 PCS)
- D. Cross connector flat tube ( 2 PCS )
- E. Upper Vertical post (2PCS)
- F. Cradle Arms (10PCS)

# Hardware: X: Long screw Y: Short Screw V. Small Nut (16 PCS) (4 PCS) (8 PCS)

## **Installation Procedure:**


#### Assembly:


- Step 1. Assemble Part A onto Part B with long Screws (X) and Small Nut (V).
- Step 2. Connect Part C with Part A with Small Short Screws (Y).
- Step 3. Assemble Part D on to Part C with long Screws (X) and nut (V).
- Step 4. Insert Vertical post Part E into Vertical Post Part C with long Screws (X) and nut (V).
- Step 5. Assemble Part D onto Part E with long Screws (X) small nut (V).
- Step 6. Insert Cradle arms Part F onto Part C & E. Insert all cradle in the same angle direction for proper alignment.

Make sure all nuts & bolts are tightened.

\*\* Caster Wheels (G-C4) can be installed on this system as option and are sold separately \*\*
