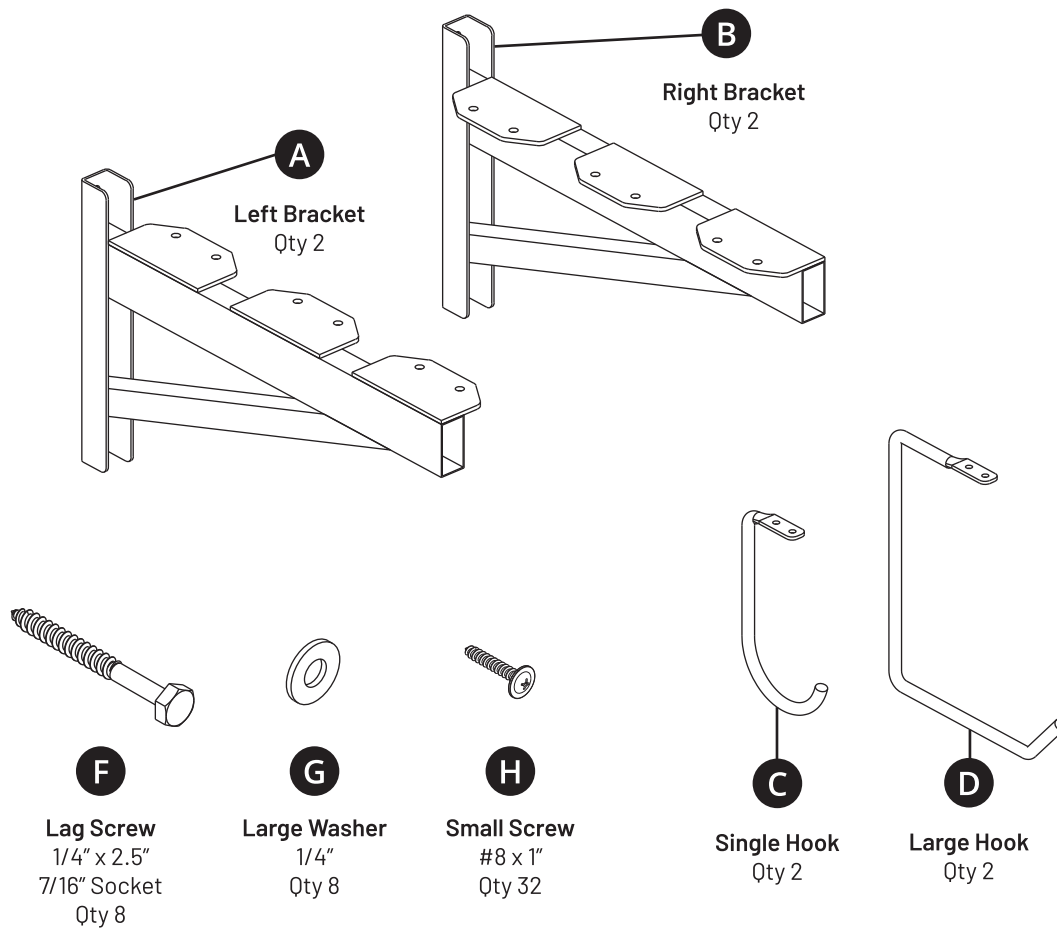
WALL SHELF PARTS

WEIGHT LIMITS:

300 lbs. per shelf when properly installed with 2x4s

REQUIRED TOOLS:

Drill/driver
3/16" (5mm) drill bit
1/16" (2mm) drill bit
7/16" Socket Driver
Phillips head screw driver
Level



These shelves are designed to be installed with brackets 4 feet apart. This setup allows you to cut a standard 8-foot 2x4 in half to get two pieces from one board.

You will need 3 standard 8-foot 2x4s (1.5 per shelf)

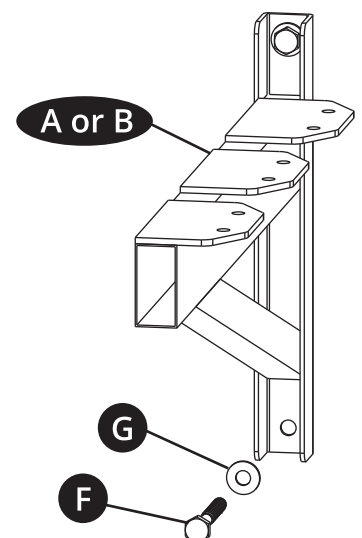
INSTALLATION STEPS

Before starting the installation, determine the size of your shelf and where you want to install it. If installing two shelves, consider the distance between them and the height at which they will be mounted.

1 Locate the Studs
Use a stud finder to identify and mark the center of nearby wall studs at the height where you will install the shelf brackets.

2 Mark the First Bracket Position
Hold the Shelf Bracket for one side against the wall and mark the hole locations along the center of the stud at the desired height.

3 Install the First Bracket
Use a 3/16" (5mm) drill bit to drill pilot holes at the marked locations
Use a 7/16" socket driver to install the Lag Screws and Washers onto the Wall Brackets.

Install the Second Bracket

Hold the other bracket against the wall at a stud location and place a level across both brackets. Adjust the height of the second bracket so it is level with the first.

Mark the hole locations of the second bracket in line with the center of the stud where it will be mounted.

Drill pilot holes and attach with the Lag Screws and Washers the same as you did for the first bracket.

Attach Shelving Material

Cut the shelving material to the correct length based on your installation type.

Hold the boards against the Shelf Bracket and use a 1/16" drill bit to drill pilot holes

Attach to the brackets with the Small Screws (H)

NOTES:

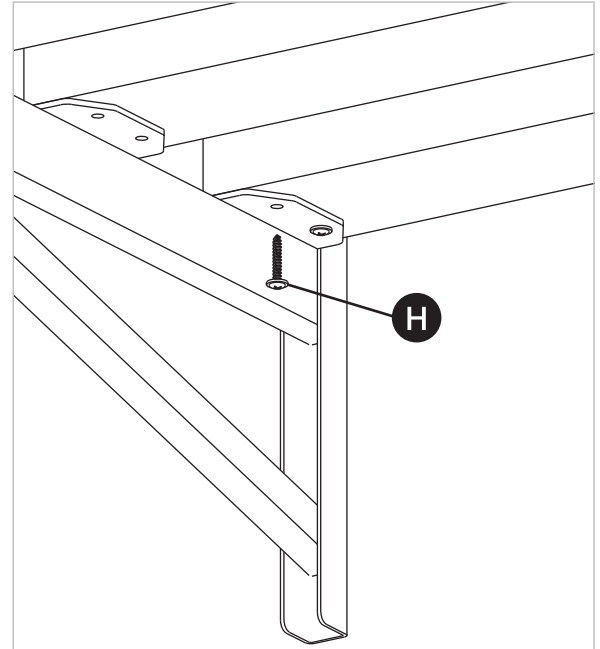
Do not overhang any 2x4s more than 6 inches from a bracket.

The weight rating of 400 pounds is for standard 2x4 installation with no overhang.

If using plywood for a solid shelf, 3/4 inch is preferred but the shelf won't be as strong.

You may also place a thin sheet of 1/4 inch plywood over the top of 2x4s for strength without gaps between the boards for smaller items.

If not following the standard installation suggestion, please use good judgment when choosing a shelf size and material.

Attach Hooks

Align the hooks where you want them under a 2x4 and mark the holes with a pencil.

Use a 1/16 inch drill bit to drill pilot holes at the marked locations.

Use a Phillips head driver to attach the hooks with Small Screws.
