
FOLDING WORKBENCH PARTS

WEIGHT LIMITS:

Drill/driver Stud Finder 3/32" (2.5mm drill bit) Phillips Screw driver Level

INSTALLATION STEPS

Wood Top

Locating Studs and Marking Holes


Start by using a stud finder and a pencil to locate and mark the center of the wall studs where you plan to mount the brackets. For standard 16" stud spacing, we recommend placing the brackets 32" apart.


Extend one of the Folding Brackets (B) to the "up" position and hold it against the wall, ensuring that the mounting holes are centered over the stud. Mark the top mounting hole location using a pencil.

Mounting the First Bracket

Drill a pilot hole at the marked location using a 3/32" (2.5mm) drill bit.

Insert a wall screw through the top mounting hole and, while holding the screw in position, press the bracket lever to collapse the Folding Bracket. Secure the screw into the pilot hole through the rectangle cutout on the top of the Folding Bracket. Avoid fully tightening it at this stage.








3 Install Remaining Screws on First Bracket

Mark the locations for the two remaining mounting holes on the bracket.

Swing the bracket out of the way to drill pilot holes in these marked locations.

Securely fasten all three screws, ensuring they are fully tightened.



4 Mounting the Second Bracket

- Use a level and a straight edge to mark hole locations for the second bracket.
- Repeat the steps outlined above to mount the second bracket securely.

5 Attaching the Wood Top

Lift the ends of both brackets to lock them in the extended position.

Center the Wood Top (A) over the two brackets, making sure it is positioned evenly.

Mark the locations for three holes underneath each bracket to attach the wood top securely.

Remove the wood top temporarily and drill pilot holes at the marked locations using a 3/32" (2.5mm) drill bit.

Carefully place the wood top back on the brackets and use a Phillips head screwdriver to attach it to the brackets using the Wood Top Screws (D). Ensure a secure connection.

Be extremely cautious not to drill through the wood top
