This system has a maximum capacity of 175 lbs per unit. Overloading the system could result in damage to property or injury.


Use extreme caution when loading and unloading equipment from this system.



PRODUCT OVERVIEW:

This Wall Hitch Mount is intended to store a hitch rack on a wall and is secured with the hitch pin that came with your hitch rack.

NOTE: The Wall Hitch Mount must be mounted to studs.

- Use a stud finder to find the stud where you want to mount the product and mark the location with a pencil. Measure the width of the accessory you intend to mount and ensure that there is enough room to mount/dismount the product from the Wall Hitch Mount.
- Hold the Wall Hitch Mount (A) up to the wall and align the mounting slots with the center of the stud. Make sure the arrow is facing up. Use a level to ensure the rack sits level to the ground and mark the top hole and bottom slot with a pencil.
- Use a 3/16 inch drill bit to drill pilot holes in the top and bottom hole locations.
- Partially insert lag screws and washers into the top and bottom hole locations. Snug up the top screw but don't fully tighten as to ensure the rack can still pivot with light resistance. Leave the bottom screw partially inserted.



- Use a level to level the Wall Hitch Mount and tighten the top and bottom screws fully.
- Use a 3/16 inch drill bit to drill a pilot hole into the middle hole location.
- Insert the last lag screw and washer, and fully tighten.
- Insert your hitch rack into the receiver and secure it with a hitch pin.

 NOTE: Hitch pin is not included. Use the pin that came with your hitch rack.
