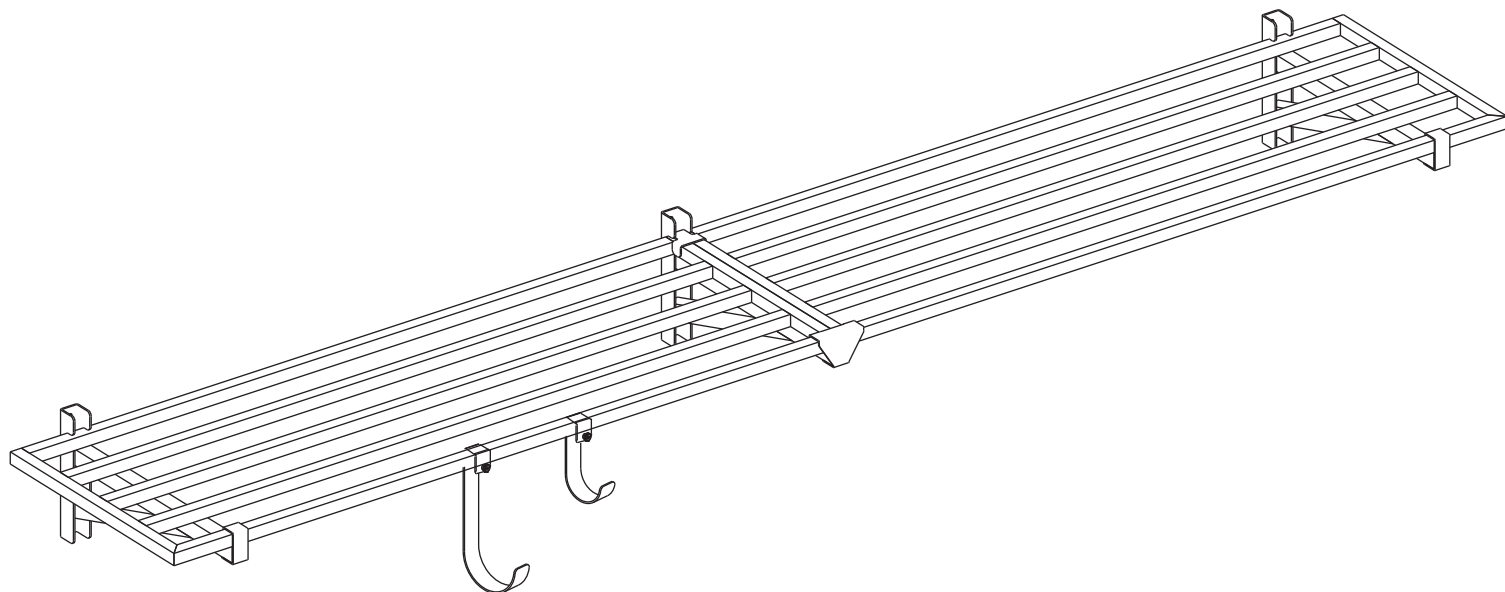

This system has a maximum capacity stated in the following section. Overloading the system could result in damage to property or injury.

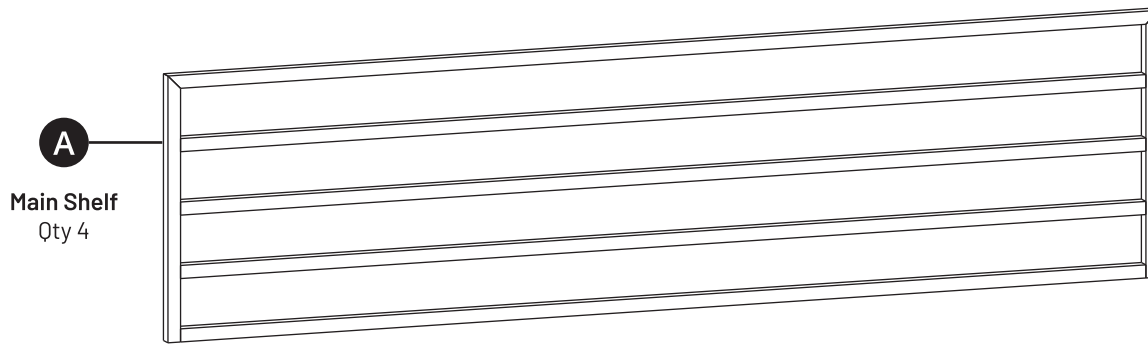
Use extreme caution when loading and unloading equipment from this system.

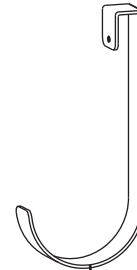

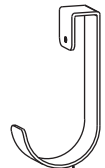

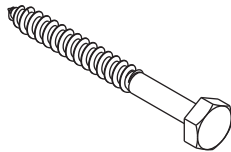

INSTALLATION STEPS

1

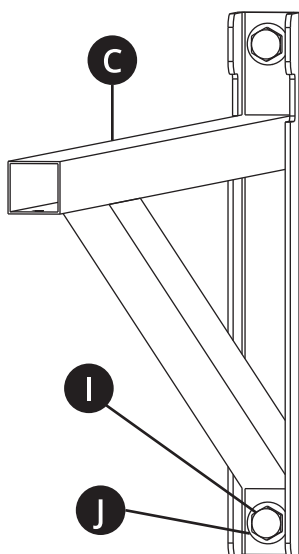
Plan where you will install the shelves. Each shelf requires 3 brackets on 3 wall studs, they share a bracket in the middle.

Use a stud finder and pencil to find and mark the center of the wall studs where you will mount the Shelf Brackets (C). Hold the Shelf Bracket for one side against the wall and mark the hole locations along the center of the stud.

Use a 3/16" (5mm) drill bit to drill pilot holes at the hole locations you marked.

Use a 12mm socket driver to install the Lag Screws and Washers onto the Wall Brackets.



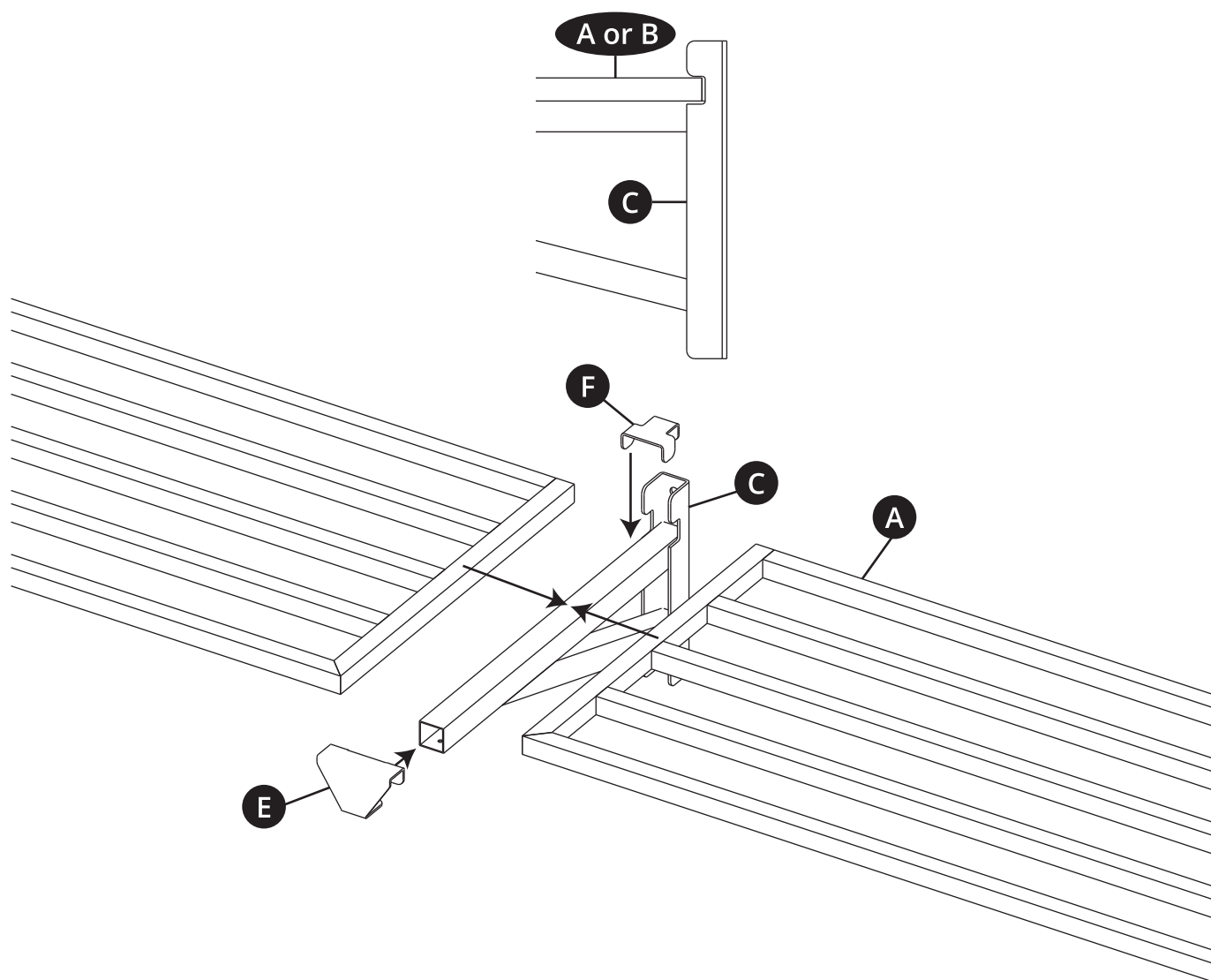

Hold the next bracket against the wall and place a level on top of the Shelf across both brackets. Adjust the height of the second bracket so the shelf is level. Mark the hole locations of the second bracket in line with the center of the stud where it will be mounted. Drill pilot holes and attach with the Lag Screws and Washers the same as you did for the first bracket.

Repeat for the third bracket and then the second shelf.

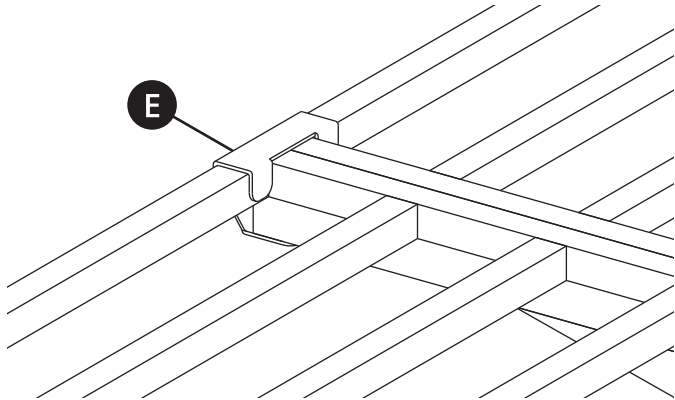

Place the Shelves (A) on the Shelf Brackets (C) and push them against the wall and into the notch. Both shelf pieces rest on the Middle Shelf Bracket. It helps to cut a small piece of cardboard from the box to put under the 2 pieces and balance on top of the Middle Shelf Bracket.



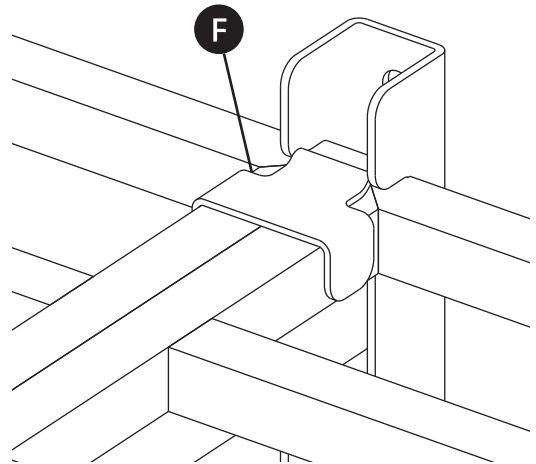

Place the Middle Front Lock (E) over the Shelves (A) and slide it over the end of the Shelf Bracket (C) so the slot on the Lock is aligned with the hole on the bottom of the Shelf Bracket. Use a Small Screw (K) to secure the Shelf Lock to the Shelf Bracket.



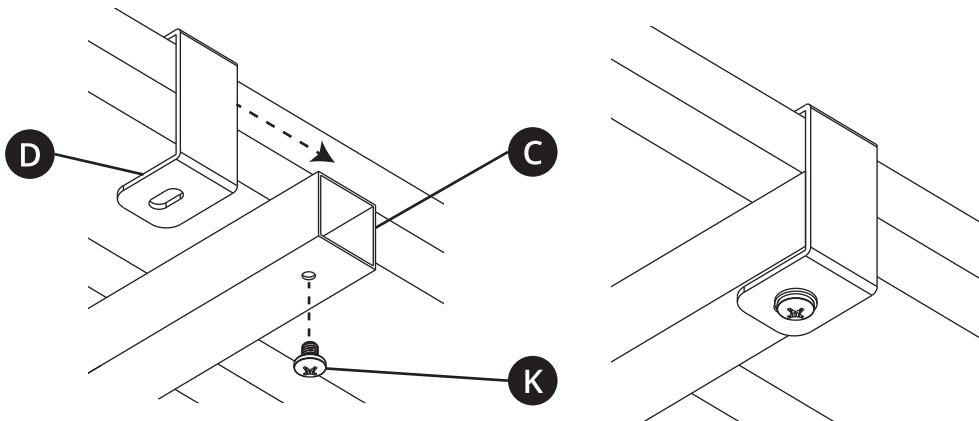

Place the Middle Rear Lock (F) over the Shelves (A) and slide it between the sides of the Middle Shelf Bracket so it holds the Shelves together and prevents side-to-side movement in the rear.



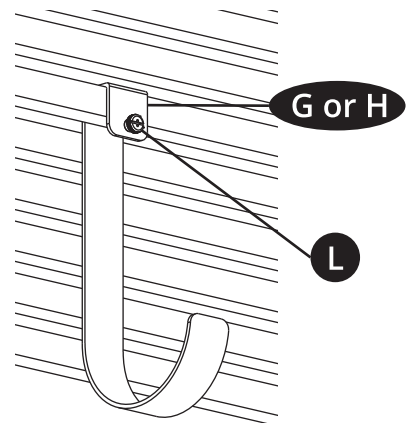

Place the Shelf Lock (D) over the Shelves (A) and slide it over the end of the Shelf Bracket (C) so the slot on the Shelf Lock is aligned with the hole on the bottom of the Shelf Bracket. Use a Small Screw (K) to secure the Shelf Lock to the Shelf Bracket.

Place the Hooks (G & H) on the tubes where you want them and attach the Thumb Screws (L) to prevent them from accidentally coming off when you load and unload your gear.
