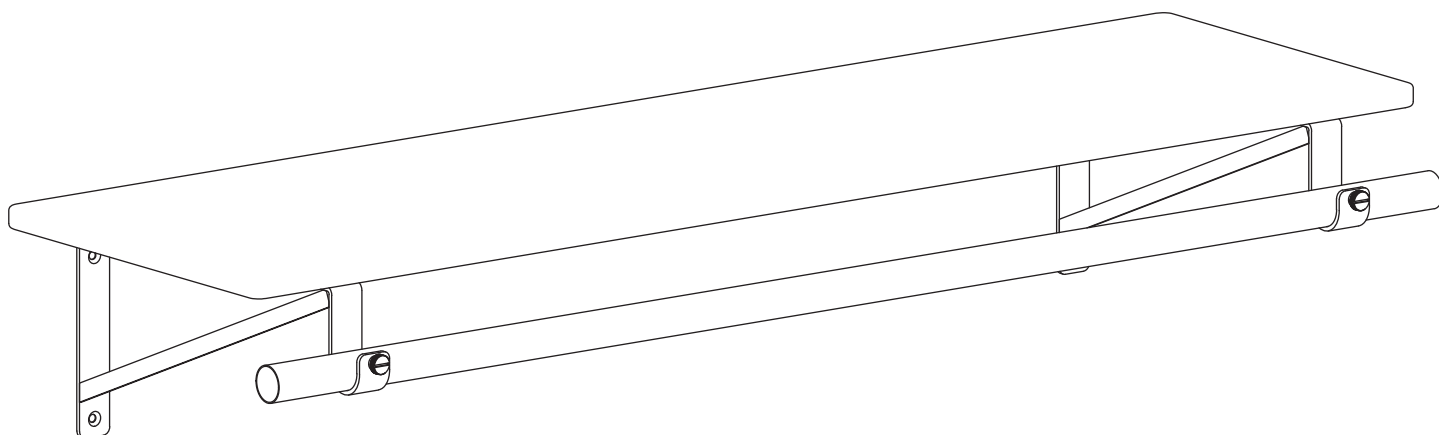

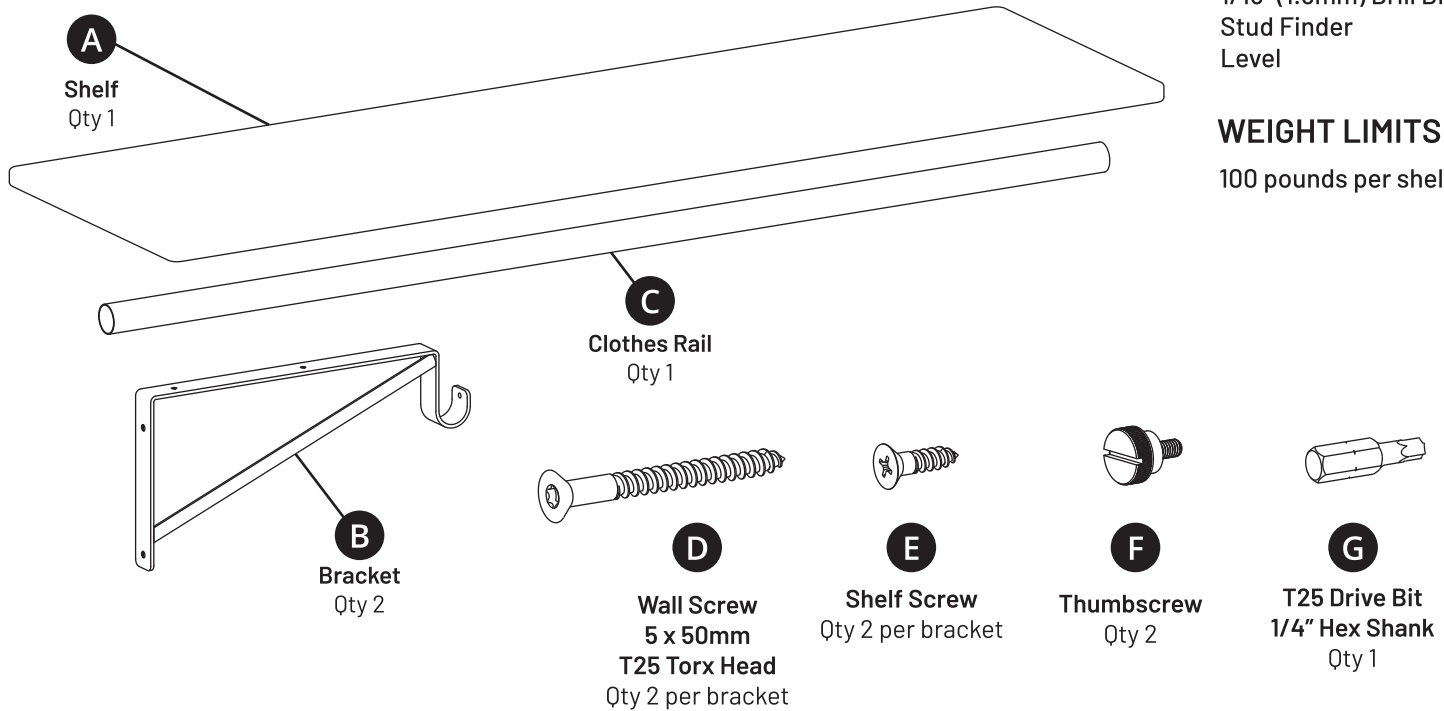
CLOTHES RAIL AND SHELF PARTS

REQUIRED TOOLS:

Drill and Driver
3/32" (2.5mm) Drill Bit
1/16" (1.5mm) Drill Bit
Stud Finder
Level

WEIGHT LIMITS:

100 pounds per shelf



INSTALLATION STEPS

1

Plan, Measure, and Locate Studs

Measure the wall space and determine where the shelf will be installed. Brackets must be mounted into wood wall studs or masonry walls.

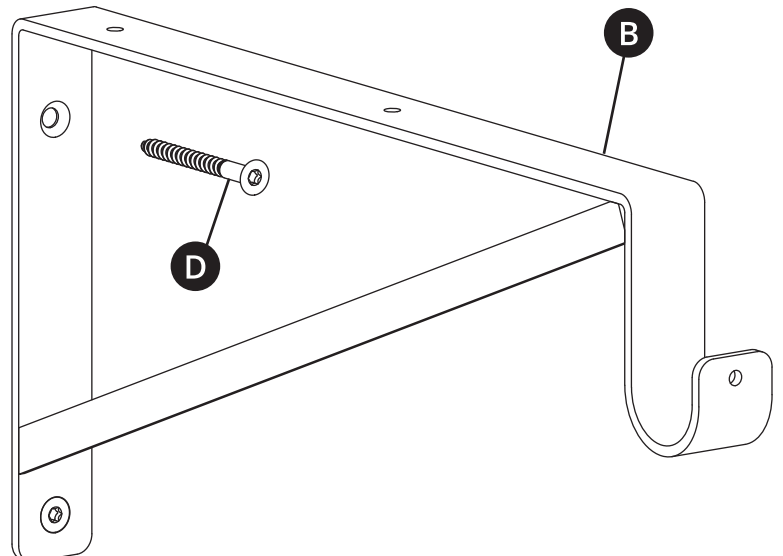
Use a stud finder to locate the studs and mark the center of each stud with a pencil at all bracket locations.

Position and Install the First Bracket

Hold the first bracket against the wall, aligning it with the center of the stud at the desired height. Use a level to ensure the bracket is level, then mark the hole locations.

Remove the bracket, drill pilot holes using a 1/8" drill bit, and secure the bracket to the wall using two Wall Screws (D).



3 Install the Second Bracket Using the Shelf as a Guide

Place one end of the shelf on the installed bracket. At the opposite end, hold the last bracket against the wall, aligning it with the center of the wall stud.

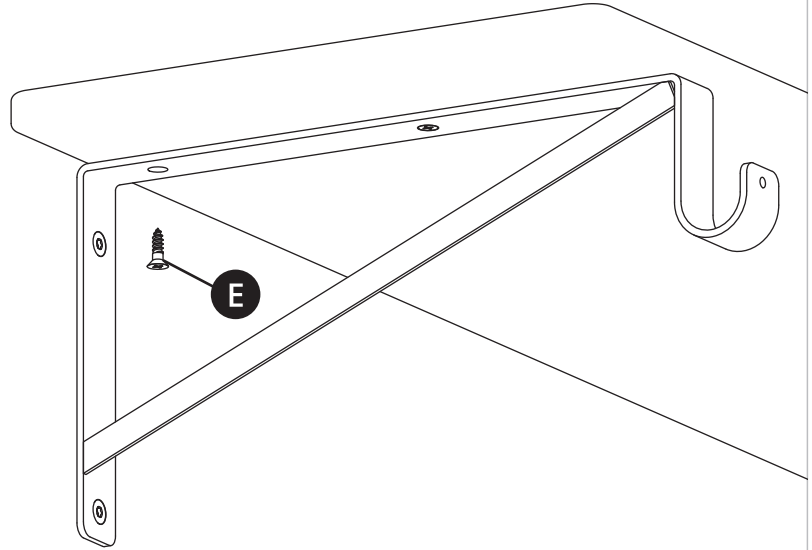
Use either a long level spanning between the brackets, or place the shelf on the brackets and set a small level on top of the shelf. Adjust the bracket until the shelf is level and the bracket is centered on the stud. Mark the hole locations, then remove the shelf and bracket.

Drill pilot holes with a 1/8" drill bit and attach the bracket using two Wall Screws (D).

4 Attach the Shelf to the Brackets

Center the shelf over the brackets and mark the shelf hole locations on both brackets. Remove the shelf and drill pilot holes using a 1/16" (1.5 mm) drill bit, being careful not to drill through the shelf.

Reinstall the shelf and attach it to the brackets using two Shelf Screws (E) per bracket.



5 Attach Clothes Rail

Center the clothes rail with the shelf and secure with Thumbscrews (F) in each bracket.
