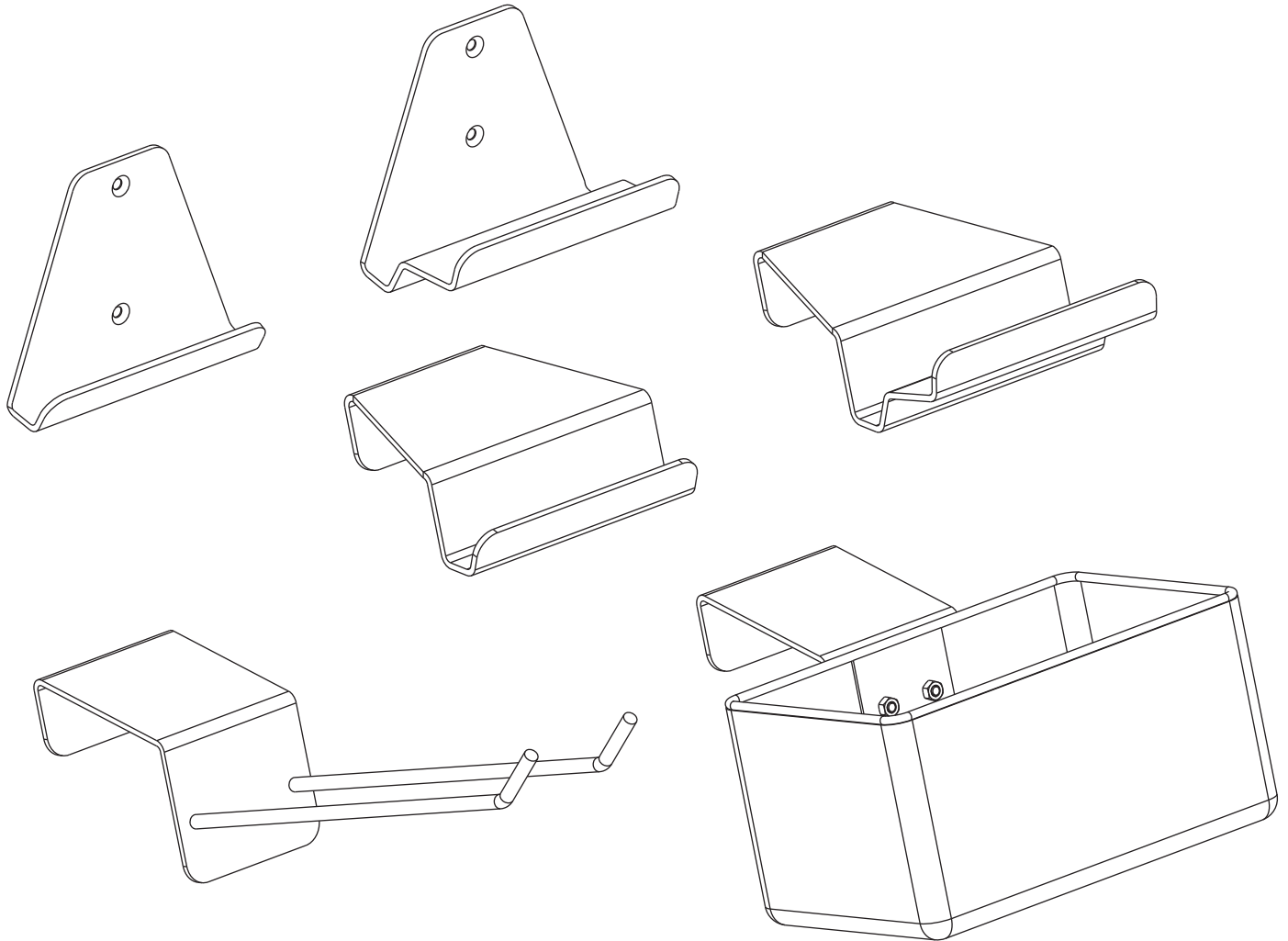

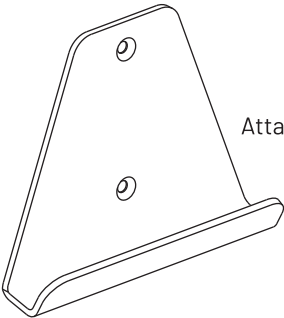

Level

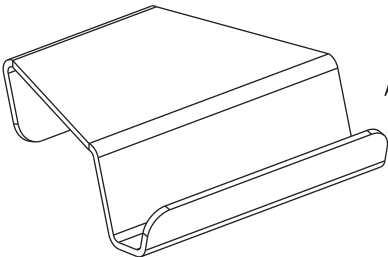

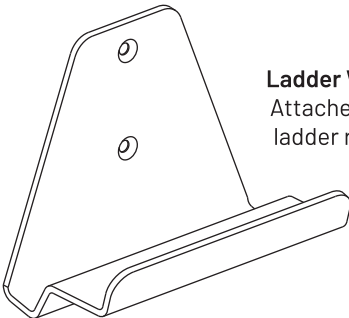
Observe ladder rung

brackets on steps



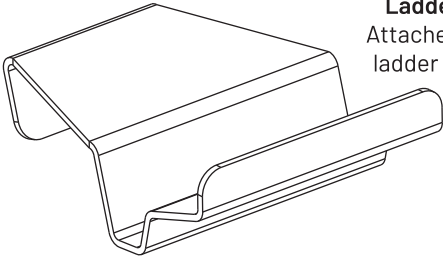
Ladder Wall Wedge

step ladder rear rails



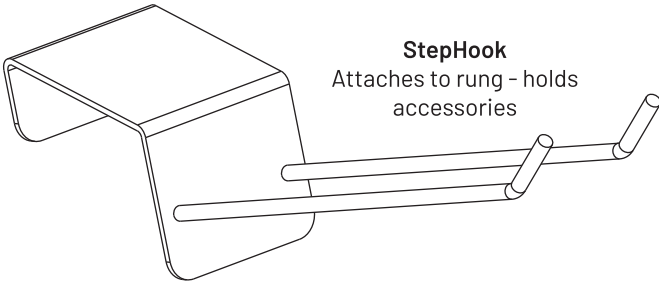
Ladder Stacker

most step ladder rear rails



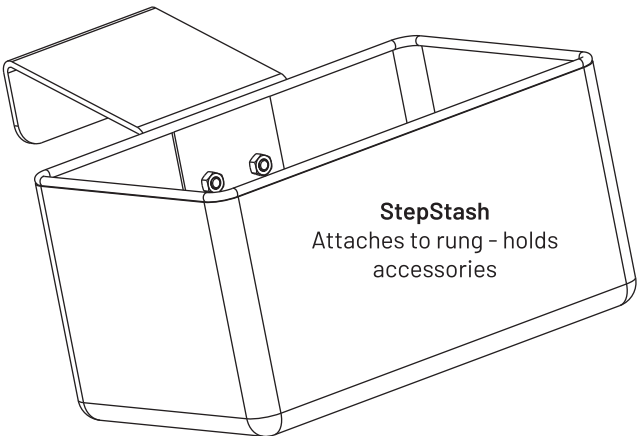
Ladder Wall Wedge | Universal

rungs



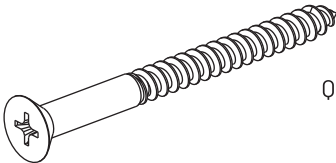
StepHook
Attaches to rung - holds
accessories

Magnetic Shim
Qty: 2 per step bracket



Wall Screw
Qty: 2 per wall wedge

INSTALLATION STEPS

1

Plan, Measure, and Locate Studs

Measure the items you plan to store and the available wall space. Decide the mounting height that provides proper clearance and accessibility.

Use a stud finder to locate the wall studs where the Wall Wedge will be installed.

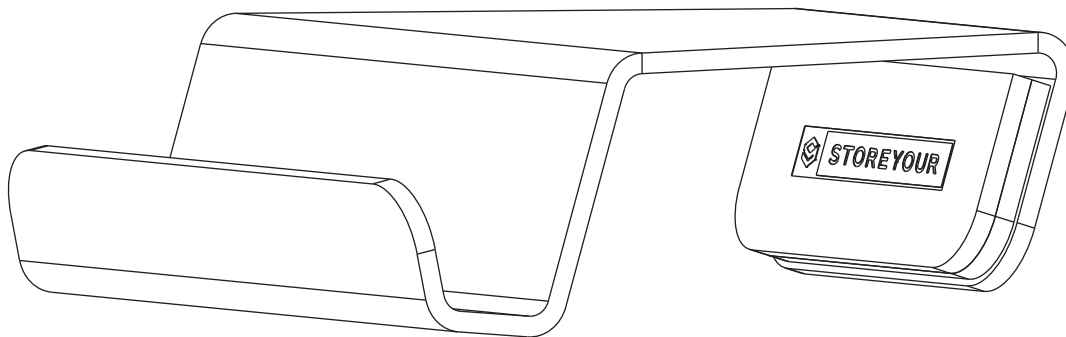
Position and Secure the Wall Wedge

- Hold the Wall Wedge against the wall at the desired height, aligning the mounting holes with the center of the stud.
- Ensure the Wall Wedge is perfectly level, then mark the hole locations with a pencil.
- Using a $3/32$ " drill bit, drill pilot holes at the marked locations and attach the Wall Wedge to the wall using 2 Wall Screws, tightening securely.
- Repeat for any additional Wall Wedges

Install the Step Brackets

Place the brackets on the ladder rung. Add or remove magnetic shims as needed for a tight fit. The shim magnets are polarized, ensure they fit together properly and the strong force is against the step bracket by placing them together and then placing them on the bracket so that the StoreYour logo faces out as shown.

Assemble the Basket

Use the 2 small screws and nuts to connect the basket to the step bracket and tighten securely.
