






INSTALLATION


- Locate and Mark the Studs: Start by finding the studs in your wall. We recommend marking three studs that are 32" apart for 16" spacing or 24" apart for 24" spacing. You can use a stud finder for this task.
- **Determine Mounting Height:** The Uprights (A) for your product are 45" long. Decide how high you want to mount them on the wall. This will depend on what you plan to store on the product and your personal preference.
- Mark the Upright Position: Once you've decided on the height, mark where the top of the upright will intersect with the studs. Remember, the top of the uprights has cutouts on the side, so ensure this section is facing towards the ceiling.

Drill the First Hole: Using a 3/32" drill bit, drill a hole 3" below the mark you made for the top of the Upright (A).


Mount the Upright: Use a Wall Screw (H) to mount the Upright (A) to the wall using only the top mounting hole. Do not fully tighten the screw yet as you may need to make adjustments.




Drill Mounting Holes: Use a level to ensure the Upright (A) is vertical and aligned with the stud. Once it's level, use a 3/32" (2.5mm) drill bit to drill pilot holes through the other two mounting holes in the upright - one in the middle and one toward the bottom.




- Secure the Upright: Use Wall Screws (H) to mount the upright into the holes you just drilled. Now you can fully tighten all the screws.
- Repeat for the Other Upright: Repeat the marking, drilling, and mounting process for the other Upright (A). Make sure the two uprights are level with the wall and each other.
- Install the Basket Brackets: Install the Basket Brackets (D) into the Uprights (A) at the location where you want the Basket (B or C). Use a Plastic Locking Clip (F) to lock it in place. Ensure the brackets are in the same position on each upright.





Use a Plastic Wall Offset: Use a Plastic Wall Offset (E) to hold the basket horizontal. These can be positioned on the bottom to hold the basket against a wall (left image), or they can be positioned on the sides to hold the basket against the upright (right image). Ensure they snap tightly onto the wire of the basket.



Repeat for Other Baskets: Repeat the process for any other baskets you want to install. If you want to move the baskets to a different level, remove the plastic lock clip from the upright, slide the bracket and basket assembly up and out of the upright, reposition it, and reinstall the plastic lock clip.
